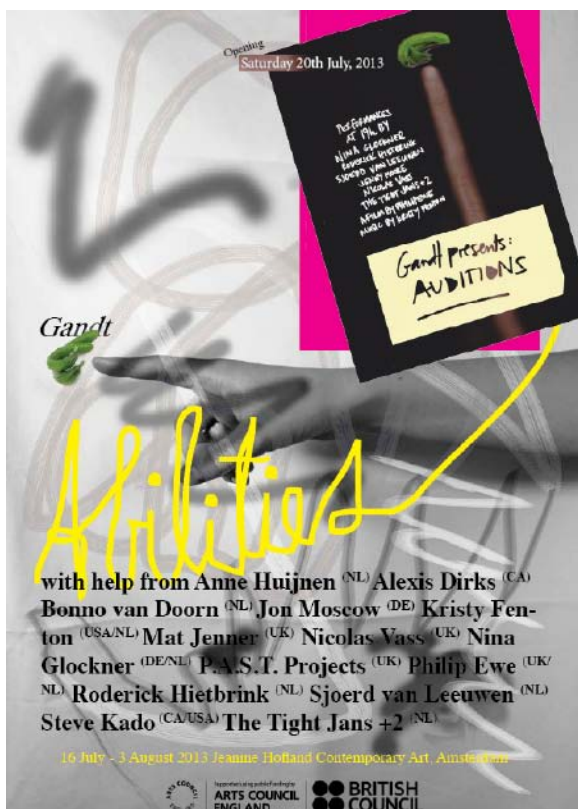

For this research residency, GANDT has invited a large group of artist based in the Netherlands and abroad to join them; together they will break down possible anxieties about staging oneself, look for a way to activate personal abilities and undermine the individualistic careerism of personal branding that is expected of artist & art professionals by the current art market.

This year Jeanine Hofland Contemporary Art's Alongside# summer residency will be hosting a research project named "Abilities", organized by Fleur van Muiswinkel and the British artist collective GANDT. Over the course of three weeks, the role of the gallery will be in a constant flux. The exhibition will turn into a stage; hosting performances, talks, a reading group, dinner and an orchestral workshop that will unearth, celebrate and express the mutual anxieties we all have but seldom express openly.
